Pentecost Sunday June 4, 2017

Bulletin Connection ~ Pentecost celebrates the gift of the Holy Spirit poured out on the disciples of Jesus. The vivid story in Acts of the Apostles, in which the Spirit comes as a mighty wind and is seen as tongues of flame, is proclaimed each year. This year's Gospel is a reprise of what we heard on the second Sunday of Easter, the extended version of which included the story of Thomas. But today we only hear of the risen Lord's appearance on Easter night. He breathes on his disciples and gives them the Holy Spirit. And, most significantly, Jesus indicates that the gift of the Spirit is tied to reconciliation!

From the Pastor

PENTECOST Today we celebrate the feast of Pentecost, one of the most ancient feasts of the Church. With the fulfillment of His promise to send the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles, Christ's mission is completed and the New Covenant begins. This is why this feast is often called "the birthday of the Church." **MSGR. JOHN RICHTER** announces his retirement from active ministry. Msgr. Richter plans to move to Villa Maria Apartments at Divine Providence in Sleepy Eye this summer. Msgr. Richter was assigned as Rector of the Cathedral in 2002. He stepped down as rector, giving up administrative duties in 2015. At age 79 he is now making another transition in his priestly ministry. He plans to celebrate daily Mass, be available for the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Anointing of the Sick and serve in other pastoral areas as his energy allows. I am grateful to Msgr. Richter for his faithfulness and dedication to the people of the AFC, especially as senior associate these past two years. A celebration to thank Msgr. Richter for his priestly ministry of 15 years in the New Ulm area is being planned.
