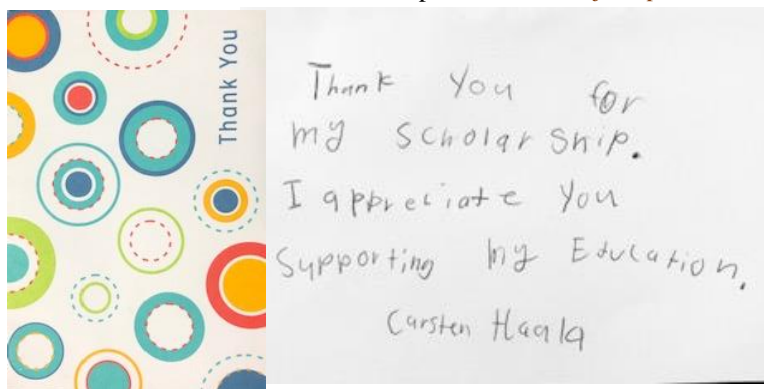

## 1. Parish Reports:

a) Cookie bake will begin Dec. 2 with pick up dates Dec. 10 and 11.

## 2. Finance Report:

a) Student Tuition Aide – all but 3 checks have been cashed, following up on the last 3.

## 3. Old Business:

a) Emergency Preparedness Plan – just needs to be written up.

b) 2022-2023 DMA Project -This year's project will be lifting/repairing the bottom front step in front of church and installing a new floor in the back kitchen room.

c) Parking lot repair was paid for from the general fund.

d) Festival/tents – We bought two new tents to replace the two borrowed tents from St. Mary's that were damaged by the winds prior to the picnic. We repaired the damaged tents to keep for St. John's.

e) We purchased a sting trimmer from Runnings to use at the cemetery and church.

## 4. New Business:

a) UFC LP Contract – We contracted 7,000 gallons at \$1.89.

b) Self-study completed and signed by the Trustees.

c) Hearing aid assist – Father Nathan got us a hearing aid assist. Ken Griebel will hook it up for us.  
d) Decision was made to pay Jerry \$20/hr for cemetery mowing.

## 5. Buildings & Grounds:

a) The requested memorial bench at the cemetery is still in the works.

b) Air conditioner repair is still in the works.

c) The Convent gutters & shingles have been repaired.

d) A request has been made for a memorial bench to be placed by the trees between the church and convent.

e) Shrubs and stones by church have been removed.

New shrubs and mulch will be installed in the Spring.

f) The ground that washed out by the steps and sidewalk leading to the Convent will be filled in.

## 6. Church Ministries:

a) There will be a Net Retreat at Searles on Oct. 26-29.

b) St. John's is planning on having an anointing mass in the Spring.

**7. With no further business,** meeting was adjourned, motioned by Jerry, seconded by Jim.
